Jazz Studies

To provide a richer understanding of the theoretical, practical, cultural, and historical aspects of teaching and performing jazz as a musical art form. *Audition Required*. 21 Credits

Music (Auditioned)

To provide a richer understanding of the history, genres, and theory of music with classes intended for music majors. *Audition required.* 25 Credits

Music (No Audition)

To provide a richer understanding of the history and genres music with classes intended for non-majors. *Audition not required.* 24 Credits

Theatre

To provide a richer understanding of the dramatic arts while developing communication and collaborative skills. *Audition not required.* 20 Credits

World Music

To provide a richer understanding of the theoretical, practical, cultural, and historical aspects of teaching and performing traditions of world music while refining performance and improvisational skills through private instruction, world music ensembles, music history, and a summer study abroad/directed research.
