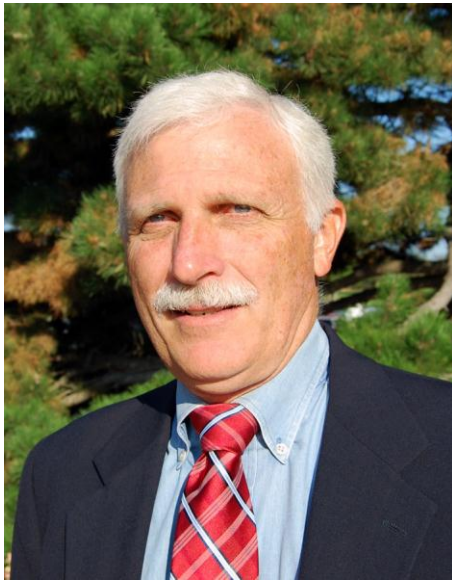


Dan Hunter
