Confined Space	Central Heating Plant	Boiler Operator CHP Supervisor	Any tasks which require entry into spaces that 1) are large enough for an employee to bodily enter; AND 2) have limited means of entry/exit; AND 3) are not designed for continuous occupancy.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Training <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ New Employee <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Present Confined Space training within first 10 days of employment (use training handout when video is unavailable) • Administer Confined Space exams • Have employees sign attendance sheets • Send copies of exams and attendance sheets to Office of EH&S ➢ Ongoing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure employees attend EH&S “re-training” ◆ Assist with the characterization of confined space <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Permit-Required <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporarily declassified • (c)(5)(i) • Permit-Required ➢ Non-Permit Required ◆ Complete and maintain any/all required recordkeeping; send one copy of all documents to the Office of EH&S. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Recordkeeping: Document Non-Permit Confined Spaces, Permit-Required Confined Space Pre-Entry Form, Declassification Form, (c)(5)(i) Form, and Entry Permit ◆ Obtain and ensure the proper use of all associated safety supplies and equipment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Gas-Tech GX-86 4-gas monitor
