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### Financial Aid Award Evaluation Worksheet

*Use this worksheet to help determine if financial aid awards will cover expenses.*

Financial awards offered to students are based on an estimated cost of attendance which includes **estimated OU charges** and **other expenses** they may have. The estimated cost of attendance is established each year to assist students with planning for college expenses. While expenses vary depending on the level of enrollment and the lifestyle of the student, average costs are reflected in the estimated cost of attendance. The estimated cost of attendance is used to award financial aid.
