Subject: Summer 2010 'Summer Session' Official Enrollment

The "final" count for the summer session aggregates data pulled at the end of the refund period for each part-of-term in the second half of the summer 2010 semester. As of the final count date for the parts of term in the second half of the summer semester, 5,642 students enrolled in 25,125 credits. FYES equals 869, up about 9% from last year. The table below shows the breakout.

\* FYES calculations exclude competency exam credits and on-line credits taken by non-resident students.

Undergraduate headcount is up over 13%, while credits are up 13% and FYES 12%. Competency credits are not included in the FYES calculation and there are more credits in competency exams this year, so the increase in credits is greater than the increase in FYES. The FYES number is a better indication of how enrollment compares to last year.

New undergraduate enrollment is strong, and returning student enrollment is also up 14%.

Graduate enrollment continues to be up across headcount, credits and FYES due to a 3% increase in returning students. Enrollment of new graduate students is down.

Below is the enrollment by part-of-term. Note that headcount in this table is duplicated, so students enrolled in more than one part-of-term in the summer session are counted in each PoT count.
