# Oakland University PSYCHOLOGICAL EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR THE CAMPUS COMMUNITY

#### THE DEAN OF STUDENTS SHALL BE NOTIFIED AT ALL TIMES

# I. <u>IRRATIONAL, UNCONTROLLABLE OR DESTRUCTIVE</u> BEHAVIOR THAT IS A THREAT TO SELF AND/OR OTHERS

Any situation in which a student appears out of touch with reality (i.e., disorganized speech, thoughts, behaviors, hallucinations)

#### Faculty/Staff response:

- Contact OU Police immediately
  - ✓ OU Police will decide the need for medical treatment.
  - OU Police will arrange for transportation to the nearest medical facility if necessary
- Contact the Dean of Students immediately
- Notify department chair or immediate supervisor

# II. SUICIDE ATTEMPTS, GESTURES, OR THREATS

- A suicide attempt or gesture is any situation in which a student tries to physically harm him/herself with the intention to kill him/herself
- A threat is any situation in which a student verbalizes his/her intentions to kill him/herself

#### Faculty/Staff response:

- Contact Oakland University Police Department (OU Police) immediately
  - ✓ OU Police will decide the need for medical treatment
  - ✓ OU Police will arrange for transportation to the nearest medical facility if necessary
- Contact the Dean of Students <u>immediately</u>
- Notify department chair or immediate supervisor

### III. DEPRESSED OR UNUSUALLY AGITATED INDIVIDUALS

Any situation in which a student demonstrates feelings of extreme anxiety, sadness, hopelessness, worthlessness, loss of interest, inconsistent class attendance, decline in hygiene, etc.

#### Faculty/Staff response:

➤ Contact the Dean of Students immediately for consultation

#### **FAMILY NOTIFICATION GUIDELINES**

- Family (i.e., parents or legal guardian) may only be called by the Dean of Students or Assistant Dean of Students
- ➤ The Dean or Assistant Dean will inform the family of university policy regarding psychological emergencies

#### MEDICAL ADMINISTRATIVE WITHDRAWAL

- A medical administrative withdrawal may be invoked if the student is unwilling or unable to request a voluntary withdrawal or if the Dean of Students deems it necessary to protect the health and safety of the student or others
- An administrative decision regarding the student's ability to remain enrolled may be made by the Dean of Students based on the following:
  - ✓ Consultation with representative(s) from the Graham Counseling Center
  - ✓ Consultation with representative(s) from the Oakland University Police
- Any decision must consider not only the psychological stability of the student, but also the broader emotional impact on members of the campus community

## **RE-ENROLLMENT PROCESS**

Students who have received a medical administrative withdrawal must contact the Dean of Students Office to complete the re-enrollment request process. This process is outlined in the Oakland University Student Code of Conduct
