

**CLEMIS AUTHORITY AGREEMENT**

**A Recommendation**

1. **Division and Department:** Finance and Operations, Police Department

2. **Introduction:** The Oakland University Police Department (OUPD) is an active member of the Court and Law Enforcement Management Information System (CLEMIS), an information management system comprised of specific software applications operated and maintained by the CLEMIS Authority for law enforcement purposes.

The CLEMIS Authority requires that a current signed agreement between participating police agencies and the Authority be maintained.

A new agreement must be signed because the CLEMIS Authority is now its own government entity, separate from Oakland County, and it requires its own agreements with the agencies and communities it serves. Oakland University's existing relationship with CLEMIS has not changed; the legal structure surrounding the organization has changed.

Upon Board approval, the OUPD will file a copy of the CLEMIS Authority Agreement along with a copy of the minutes from the Board meeting authorizing the appropriate signatures.

3. **Previous Board Action:** The previous agreement signed by the board on June 6, 2016, and August 12, 2021.

4. **Budget Implications:** All costs associated with the CLEMIS Authority Agreement continue to be funded through the OUPD operating budget. There are no incremental costs.

5. **Educational Implications:** None.

6. **Personnel Implications:** None.

7. **University Reviews/Approvals:** This recommendation was prepared by the OUPD Chief of Police and reviewed by the Senior Vice President for Finance and Administration and Treasurer to the Board of Trustees.

8. **Recommendation:** It is recommended that the Board of Trustees adopt the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Oakland University Police Department (OUPD) functions as an active member of the Court and Law Enforcement Management Information System (CLEMIS); and

WHEREAS, the OUPD wishes to continue having the services of CLEMIS (now recognized as The CLEMIS Authority) provided to the University Police Department; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Senior Vice President for Finance and Administration and Treasurer to the Board of Trustees to execute the CLEMIS Authority Agreement for law enforcement purposes; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the President, the Senior Vice President for Finance and Administration and Treasurer to the Board of Trustees and their respective designees, to perform all acts and deeds and to execute and deliver all contracts, instruments and documents required by this resolution that are necessary, expedient and proper in connection with the CLEMIS Authority Agreement and the ongoing administration of CLEMIS software; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that said contracts, instruments, and documents shall be reviewed by and be in a form acceptable to the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel prior to execution, and be in compliance with the law and with University policies and regulations and conform to the legal standards of the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel.




