

GENERAL EDUCATION

Completing OU’s General Education requirement by individual category

For this option, each of the below categories must be fulfilled by completing at least one course of 3 or more credits. A course may not be used in more than one of the categories numbered 1-10.

U.S. Diversity – When a course is approved for both the U.S. Diversity requirement and one of the categories numbered 1-10, it may count toward both requirements.

10. Knowledge Applications	Must be outside of OU Major area (confirm course choice with OU adviser) MTH 136; PSY 210
U.S. Diversity – When a course is approved for both this and one of the above categories, it may count toward both requirements.	CSJ 101; HST 121, 122; PLS 122

NOTES:

- Additional General Education requirements (Capstone & Writing Intensive in Major) are required to be completed at OU.
- The MACRAO stamp will always be recognized by Oakland University.
- A minimum of 45 credits must be completed at OU.
- Lower level courses which transfer in as upper level Oakland University courses will not be counted toward 3000-4000 level credit to meet OU degree requirements.
