TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. NOTES:

HFC and OU currently have an <u>articulation agreement</u> that allows students to transfer in more credits than usual. Meet with an HFC academic adviser to learn more about this opportunity.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Henry Ford, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Henry Ford academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

Students must have a minimum cumulative transfer GPA of 2.5 in order to be admitted to the Public Health curriculum.

OU's Public Health program is ranked within the top 10 programs in the country, and is accredited with the National Wellness Institute.

Earn a Master of Public Health (MPH) in addition to a bachelor's degree with the Public Health combined program!

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.

OU's <u>ECLIPSE program</u>, a unique community-engaged leadership initiative, is one of only a few health-science specific leadership programs in the country.
