When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at KVCC or at the [KVCC MTA Approved Courses](#) website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.

Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide

(minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):

- ENG 160 (required prerequisite for OU coursework)
- One MTA Approved English Composition or Communications course
- One MTA Approved Natural Sciences course
- One MTA Approved Math course
- Two MTA Approved Humanities or Fine Arts courses

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from KVCC, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
