### NOTES:

Lansing and OU currently have an <u>articulation agreement</u> that allows students to transfer in more credits than usual. Meet with a Lansing adviser to learn more about this opportunity.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Lansing, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Lansing academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

The program also offers a unique <u>Orthotist and Prosthetist Assistant Studies (OPA) concentration</u>, which equips students with the skills needed for one-on-one patient care under the direction of a certified orthotist or prosthetist. **Students interested in this concentration can also transfer CHSE 120 from Lansing to OU**.

OU's <u>ECLIPSE program</u>, a unique community-engaged leadership initiative, is one of only a few health-science specific leadership programs in the country.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
