MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

Oakland University Courses	Macomb Community College Options
Select up to 4 courses from this list of English Electives:	ENGL 2000, 2410, 2420, 2510, 2520, 2600, 2610, 2710, 2715, 2720, 2725, 2730, 2740 ; Only one of the 4 courses may come from these: ENGL 1730, 2800, 2810, 2850; HUMN 1750

COREQUISITES: Select from the two options below

An introductory two-semester foreign language sequence OR an introductory two-semester sign language sequence	ARAB, CHIN, FREN, GRMN, ITAL, SPAN (1460, <u>and</u> 1470) <i>OR</i> SIGN 1010 <u>and</u> 1020
One second semester (or higher) foreign language course OR one second semester (or higher) sign language course	ARAB, CHIN, FREN, GRMN, ITAL, SPAN 1470, 2460 <i>or</i> 2470; <i>OR</i> SIGN 1020, <i>or</i> 1030

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Macomb, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Macomb counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at MCC or at the MCC MTA Approved Courses website. To best complete OU's transferable General Education requirements, please reference the MCC General Education Transfer Guide and take the following:

- One course from OU's Writing Foundations category
 (this serves as an MTA English Composition course and is a prerequisite for coursework at OU)
- One course from OU's Knowledge Applications category (met when a 2000-level foreign language or SIGN 1030 is chosen above)

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. When following this major guide, please reference the MCC General Education Transfer Guide for the MCC courses that satisfy these specific OU General Education categories:

- Writing Foundations
- Formal Reasoning
- Arts
- Global Perspective
- Natural Science and Technology

- Social Science
- Western Civilization
- Knowledge Applications (met when a 2000-level foreign language or SIGN 1030 is chosen above)
- U.S. Diversity (may be met by choosing **ENGL 2740**)

EXPLORATORY REQUIREMENT:

Students with majors in the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) must satisfy an exploratory requirement. This can be done by completing a double major or a CAS minor or concentration; or by completing a minimum of 12 credits in a single CAS rubric, outside of their major rubric. For additional options visit oakland.edu/exploratory . Please confirm transfer course choices with an OU CAS adviser. Students using MTA or MACRAO must complete the exploratory requirement at Oakland University or another four-year institution.





NOTES:

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.

The College of Arts and Sciences requires that a minimum of 16 credits in the major be completed at Oakland University.
