

# Bachelor of Arts with a major in Social Studies with History for Educators

Students interested in continuing towards a secondary education certification will transition into the <u>Social Studies</u> with <u>History for Educators</u>, <u>B.A./Teaching in Secondary Education</u>, <u>MAT</u>, <u>Combined B.A./MAT</u>. At the undergraduate level, the Combined BA/MAT program allows students to apply for and receive delayed admission into the MAT program.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Macomb, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Macomb counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.
