TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Mott or at the Mott MTA Approved Courses website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.

Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide (minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):

ENGL 101 and ENGL 102 (required prerequisite for coursework at OU)

One MTA Approved Math course (can be satisfied by MATH elective options above)

One MTA Approved Natural Sciences course (can be satisfied by CHEM or PHYS elective options above)

One MTA Approved Social Sciences course (can be satisfied by SOCY 191)

Two MTA Approved Humanities or Fine Arts courses (can be satisfied by completing ASL 100 and COMM 131)

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. When following this major guide, please reference the Mott General Education Transfer Guide for the Mott courses that satisfy these specific OU General Education categories:

- Writing Foundations (ENGL 102)
- Formal Reasoning (MATH 150 or MATH 170)
- Arts
- Language and Culture (ASL 100)
- Global Perspective

NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Mott, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Mott academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
