

Bachelor of Arts with a major in Integrated Science

Students interested in continuing towards **Secondary Education Teacher Certification** will transition into the <u>Combined Bachelor of Arts (BA)/Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT)</u>. At the undergraduate level, the Combined BA/MAT program allows students to apply for and receive delayed admission into the MAT program.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from OCC, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their OCC counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at OCC or at the OCC MTA Approved Courses website. *Note: Education majors must complete WRT 1060 (or its equivalent) with a minimum grade of B or 3.0

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead.
